2025-2026 Service Hour Requirements

Your service hours are greatly appreciated. The fees paid by the skaters do not fully cover the cost of Club ice. Thanks to your efforts, GGBFSC is able to provide ice at a reasonable cost. The GGBFSC requires nearly 10,000 service hours per year from its membership to operate its activities and events. The service year matches the USFSA membership year of July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026.

All Introductory & Full Club member families will be required to complete all 6 requirements for service hours by 6/30/2026:

- 1. Volunteer five hours between our two GGBFSC Sponsored Camps
- 2. Volunteer five hours at the GGBFSC Annual Ice Show
- 3. Volunteer 1 session at each participating GGBFSC Club test session.
- 4. 4 hours of ice monitoring during Fall & 4 hours during Spring Ice Sessions.(Note: Summer monitoring hours can be used to fulfill Fall hours.)
- 5. Volunteer 5 hours at club hosted/sponsored competition (if held).
- 6. Volunteer an additional 15 hours for full and introductory members. The additional 15 hour requirement can be waived if involved in a committee and attend 75% of the meetings

Note: Ice Monitoring DOES NOT count towards the required 15 additional/committee volunteering requirements.
